Exhibitors include specialist training providers at 16+ for SEND and EHCP, the region's colleges, sixth forms and universities, public and private sector employers from Cornwall and beyond in a wide range of occupational sectors, careers advisors and apprenticeship experts and more!

College and sixth form applications
