Organise



- All students are given a preparing for an assessment knowledge organizer booklet at the beginning of each learning cycle
- All students are expected to be able to prioritize the topics they need to focus on by RAG their PLCs
- All students are expected to organize their time to complete their home learning activities

Strategy	Top tips
 RAG a PLC	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) At the beginning of a learning cycle students are to RAG the key ideas they are studying by self-assessing if they are Red – no understanding, Amber – some understanding, Green – full understanding. They are then to put a R, A or G in the organise column.2) Students will then prioritise the Red and Amber key ideas when they are revising.3) Students are to summarise the knowledge for each key idea, then use recall strategies before self-quizzing.
 Home learning timetable	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1) Students are to identify when their home learning activities are due2) Students are to identify when they can not complete their home learning, such as when they have other commitments (such as clubs/fixtures)3) Students are to schedule when they will complete each home learning activity—leaving time to ask for help if needed.
