



There are four stages to effectively revise. This strategy is called SORT and will help you to memorise and recall key information:

| S   | Summarise | Summarise your class notes using flash cards, mind maps, Cornel notes, revision clocks etc  | This will form the majority of home learning activities and should be ongoing throughout the learning cycles                  |

| • O | Organise  | Organise you revision<br>materials by topic/sub<br>topic. Traffic light your PLC<br>sheets to identify areas of<br>weakness or gaps                     | This should be done at the beginning of each learning cycle. And revisited each time you master a topic or sub-topic          |
| R   | Recall    | Use active recall and spaced repetition to memorise the knowledge until you can recall the Information eg. Look, cover, write, blurt it or self-testing | This will be part of the expectation of home learning activities set – you need to actively memorise key knowledge and skills |
|     | Test      | Use low stakes online tests/<br>quizzes and answer high<br>stakes past paper/sample<br>questions to check and<br>apply knowledge and<br>understanding   | This will be done as part of every home learning activity and as part of retrieval starters in lessons.                       |
