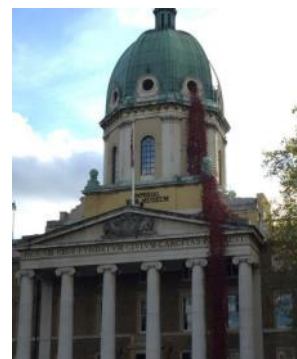


London Trip
