Re: Bath University Trip – Friday 21<sup>st</sup> April

We are delighted to be able to offer students the opportunity to visit Bath University on Friday 21<sup>st</sup> April in what will be an inspirational day for any student wanting to attend University.

We will leave Poltair School at 7.30am prompt and travel by coach to Bath University. We will spend the day touring the sports facilities, meeting high performance athletes and trailing sport specific sessions that will incorporate agility, speed and hand eye co-ordination.
