## Keyworker Support Programme

Monday 4<sup>th</sup> December sees the launch of our Keyworker Support Programme. Each student will be allocated a member of staff who will support them in their Year 11 pathway to success. This may be their tutor, one of the pastoral team or a member of the Senior Leadership Team.

The programme encompasses:

- Keyworkers having a weekly meeting with students to make sure they are finishing their homework and staying on top of their revision.
- Ensuring that students are following revision schedules and assisting students in organizing their time and workload for the upcoming week, which includes attending masterclasses.
- Encouraging #revise50.
- Keyworkers monitoring students' behaviour and attendance, and when needed, assist them by removing any obstacles.
- Celebrating accomplishments.
- Assistance with managing exam anxiety and general well-being.

In addition, students will be encouraged to carry out independent revision during tutor time every Monday.
