Re: Curriculum Enrichment Week 2023 – Week beginning 22nd July 2024

We have an exciting opportunity for Year 7 students to take part in the 2024 Curriculum Enrichment Week.

Year 7 students are invited to join us on a week of survival activities: students will undertake a 2½ day residential camp at Footsteps to Discovery in Mitchell and spend 2½ days in school where they will undertake exciting team building activities with their peers.

For each year group the week will be divided into two parts where one group will attend a residential camp from Monday morning until Wednesday morning followed by school-based activities, the other group of students will remain in school at the beginning of the week and then attend the camp on Wednesday afternoon. We will be able to confirm the exact student groupings for this nearer the time.

Travel Information

All travel arrangements are included in the cost. Students leaving for the residential camp on Monday will leave school at approximately 9:00am and return on Wednesday at approximately 12:00pm. Students attending the residential camp on Wednesday will leave at approximately 12:00pm and will return at approximately 3:00pm on Friday.

Emergency Contacts

In the event of an emergency, or if we have any concerns, we will contact you by phone using the details held on our school system. If you need to contact your child urgently staff can be contacted on the school mobile phone and again, the number for this will be shared nearer the time. We can confirm that this mobile phone will be checked regularly between 7:00am and 11:00pm, unless we are supervising students in an environment that requires our support. We would urge parents to contact staff in the first instance if there is a problem at home that parents wish to notify students of.

Medical Information/Consent

May we take this opportunity to remind parents and carers that we will require information and/or a Care Plan for students with medication needs.

Mobile Phones and Tablets

We discourage the use of mobile telephones as it detracts from the whole experience. It is also worth noting that there is no recharging provision available, and they can easily be lost. Similarly, we discourage the use of tablets and other devices. Neither the residential venues or Poltair School will take responsibility for electronic equipment which is lost or damaged. The use of any electronic equipment will be under the direction of staff.

Prohibited

Other than the kit listed below, the providers will supply all the equipment required for a full residential experience. Please do not send your child on the camp with any additional food or snacks, knives, pen knives, fire lighter's, axes, saws and lighters or any other additional items required for an overnight stay.
