Tetanus/Diphtheria/Polio and Meningitis ACWY

Do you have a child in year 10 or 11? Did they receive their Tetanus/Diphtheria/Polio and Meningitis ACWY vaccines in year 9?

- These are very important vaccines which will usually complete the routine childhood vaccinations, providing boosters from when your child was pre-school.
- If you are unsure, please call the team on 01872 221105 for Cornwall schools and 01392 342678 for Devon schools and we will be able to advise. If you have consented and now wish to withdraw consent, please contact Kernow Health in the first instance.

If you have not submitted a consent form, please click on this link <u>www.kernowimmunisations.co.uk/Forms/DTP.aspx</u> and enter the unique school code **EE112052** where asked to do so.

- We will be visiting the school on Thursday 29th February 2024 and again later in the year as well as running some community catch-up clinics at various venues around the counties. We will give every opportunity for you to have your child immunised. Please submit your consent form by midday on Tuesday 27th February 2024 in order to ensure your child receives their vaccination.
- Your child can self-consent to treatment if they are considered competent to do so by one of our nurses; this is known as Gillick competency. If you require any further information in this regard, please contact us or go to <u>https://www.nhs.uk/conditions/consent-to-</u> <u>treatment/children/</u>

If a consent form is not submitted your child might <u>not</u> be vaccinated. If you decide not to have your child vaccinated it would help us if you complete a form and tick 'no' consent stating your reasons.
